SUMMARY

Vacating a portion of the public Right of Way in order to clean up the excess Right of Way. Public notice has been completed for the Right of Way vacation consistent with Minnesota Stat. 412.851. This action also requires a Public Hearing.

BACKGROUND

DISCUSSION

At the time the Red Cedar Point Lake Minnewashta Plat was recorded, a Right of Way was dedicated that could have accommodated the future construction of a street or alley connection between Juniper

Avenue and Red Cedar Point Road. This corridor currently functions as a drainage pathway and will continue to be maintained through a drainage and utility easement.

A portion of the Right of Way was previously vacated through prior applications. The proposed action would vacate the remaining portion of the unused Right of Way, as it is no longer needed for public street purposes.

There will remain a drainage and utility easement over the entire of the vacated Right of Way.
