SUMMARY

BACKGROUND

The Office of the State Auditor and the Minnesota Council on Local Results and Innovation have developed a voluntary comprehensive performance measurement program as established in Minnesota Statute Section 6.91. There are benefits to the city for participation, including exemption from property tax levy limits (if they are in effect) and a reimbursement of \$.14 per capita, which would result in an annual reimbursement of approximately \$3,640.

The city participated in the program last year and received a reimbursement of \$3,624.

The City Council is required to adopt and implement ten minimum performance measures (out of 29

choices) and report on them annually. The attached report shows the performance measures the city adopted and compares results for 2022 and 2023. The city is currently reporting on 17 of the 29 items and will add items when possible.

Staff recommends the City Council adopt the resolution authorizing participation in the Performance Measures Program.
