SUGGESTED ACTION:

Consider a resolution in support of a change of boundary line from Cherokee County to Cobb County.

FACTS AND ISSUES:

Castle Partners, LP owns a 2.613-acre tract of real property in unincorporated Cherokee County, and the subject property is a portion of a tract of land also owned by Castle Partners, LP that includes 7.765 acres in unincorporated Cobb County and 11.783 acres in unincorporated Bartow County.

Castle Partners, LP has filed a petition to change the county boundary line in the Probate Court of Cherokee County to move the boundary line of subject property northward so that it is fully within the boundaries of unincorporated Cobb County.

The subject property was closed off from the remainder of Cherokee County when Interstate 75 was constructed, rendering the subject property inaccessible for services, except by roads owned and maintained by Cobb County. Cherokee County has limited ability to provide services to the subject property because all access is located in Cobb County.
