SUGGESTED ACTION:

Consider agreement with Shiloh Baptist Church of Jasper, Inc., to allow the church to remove and take ownership of the modular building located at the old Public Works Facility and no longer in use by the County.

FACTS AND ISSUES:

The County is in possession of a modular building that is no longer needed. Currently it is being used as the sign shop for Public Works at 403 Chattin Drive. To make room for the future Sheriff's Officer K-9 and Traffic Precinct construction, the building will need to be removed once Public Works vacates the site. In lieu of costs incurred for disposing of the building, Shiloh Church will incur those costs and take ownership of the building.
