

SUBJECT: **Outdoor Warning Siren Maintenance Agreement.** **MEETING DATE:** November 1, 2022

SUGGESTED ACTION:

Consider approving Standard Professional Services agreement with Meer Electric for maintenance and repairs to EMA's outdoor warning sirens for a three-year term.

FACTS AND ISSUES:

The Emergency Management Agency (EMA) has 58 Federal Model 2001 Outdoor Warning Sirens located throughout the county that require annual servicing and maintenance. These sirens are used to warn residents of tornadoes and severe weather events.

RFP 2022-073 was issued to establish a contract for this maintenance. Two proposals were received from certified Federal Warning Siren Technicians. Meer Electric was the highest scoring bidder and is the current service provider with excellent service and quick response times. The agreement offers discounted standardized pricing on labor and parts. The initial term is for 3 years with the option to renew for 2 additional one-year terms.

In FY2022, EMA spent approximately \$23,000 on these parts and repairs and has \$55,000 budgeted for this fiscal year.
