**SUGGESTED ACTION:**  
Consider adoption of the 2022 Comprehensive Transportation Plan Update.

**FACTS AND ISSUES:**

The last Comprehensive Transportation Plan (CTP) Update was completed in 2016. That CTP identified transportation improvement opportunities and projects through the horizon year of 2040. This CTP update build upon the previous CTP and identifies and recommends projects to a new horizon year of 2050.

The purpose of the CTP update is to identify a countywide transportation vision and to prioritize transportation improvements in the near, mid and long-term. This CTP update considers all forms of transportation including automobiles, transit, walking, biking, freight and emerging transportation technologies.

The CTP followed the below process and completed the following tasks:

- Established clear vision, goals and objectives;
- Developed an interactive transportation model for the County's use;
- Updated the Trails Master Plan;
- Updated the Transit Services Assessment;
- Developed a prioritized list of transportation projects for the short, mid and long-terms and created a list of recommended transportation programs and policies;
- Completed a final recommendations documentation report.

The CTP has incorporated the input and feedback from multiple public and stakeholder groups including a Technical Advisory Committee, a Citizen Advisory Committee and the general public. These groups have been engaged through public and committee meetings, an interactive project website, an online survey and other engagement tactics. The TAC and CAC provided technical and practical feedback which guided the overall development of the CTP.
