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**SUGGESTED ACTION:**

Consider request from Radio Technology Department to enter into an agreement with the Georgia Department of Public Safety to patch their communications system to our communications system to enable direct communication between Cherokee County and the Georgia Department of Public Safety (DPS), as well as other state law enforcement agencies.

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**FACTS AND ISSUES:**

This agreement establishes a framework for sharing designated radio talk groups between Cherokee County and the Georgia Department of Public Safety (DPS) to enhance public safety and ensure interoperability. As part of the agreement, DPS will provide and connect six (6) donor radios to their communication system. Three (3) allocated for use by Sheriff's Office and three (3) designated for the cities of Canton, Woodstock and Holly Springs. The State will bear its own costs, with no exchange of funds, and the agreement does not create obligations or rights for other agencies or officials.

The term of the agreement is one year with the option to renew up to four additional one-year terms.
