SUGGESTED ACTION:

Consider accepting the Public Safety and Community Violence Reduction ARPA grant from the State Office of Planning and Budget in the amount of \$518,787.50 on behalf of the Sheriff's Office for the purchase of license plate reading cameras and consider authorizing a Budget Amendment to allocate the grant funds.

FACTS AND ISSUES:

On December 6, 2022, the Board authorized the Sheriff's Office to apply for a Public Safety and Community Violence Reduction Grant from the State Fiscal Recovery ARPA Funds. The Sheriff's Office has been notified that they were awarded \$518,787.50 which they will use to purchase 35 Flock safety cameras that automatically read and capture license plates.

A Budget Amendment is required to allocate the grant funds to the County's adopted FY2023 Budget.
