Amicalola EMC Relocation - Rhine Road October 4, 2022

Roadway Improvement Project.

SUGGESTED ACTION:

Consider approval of an invoice from Amicalola EMC in the amount of \$314,737.29 for the relocation of facilities in conflict with the Rhine Road Roadway Improvement Project.

FACTS AND ISSUES:

Rhine Road is a local, substandard roadway located in the western portion of Cherokee County, near the Bartow County line. It begins at SR 20 and continues south approximately 1.0 mile before ending at Upper Sweetwater Trail. It is characterized by narrow pavement, poor drainage and poor vertical alignment.

Cherokee County intends to improve Rhine Road to bring it up to current standards. The minimum pavement width desired is 20 feet with a design speed of 25 MPH. Vertical and horizontal alignment will be modified to reach current standards.

Amicalola EMC has 6 poles in conflict with the proposed project. They have submitted a cost estimate and invoice for the relocation of the 6 poles.
