

SUBJECT: Justice Center Surveillance Cameras.

SUGGESTED ACTION:

Consider approval for the purchase of digital surveillance camera equipment for the Justice Center, on behalf of the Sheriff's Office Court Services Division, from low bidder Vicon, in the total amount of \$70,366.50.

FACTS AND ISSUES:

The Sheriff's Office Court Services Division is in need of upgrades to the surveillance camera system at the Justice Center and ARPA funds were allocated for this work. The work has been broken down into phases including - IT infrastructure, camera hardware, camera software/storage and cabling upgrades. Property Management received quotes for the camera hardware which includes changing current analog cameras to digital, filling the gaps and adding additional cameras to both the inside and outside of the Justice Center. The upgraded hardware will allow the surveillance system to function at the needed level for the next 10-15 years.

Quotes were received from the following vendors:

- 1. Vicon = \$70,366.50
- 2. Mobile Communications America = \$79,516.78
- 3. Wholesale Industrial Electronics = \$80,217.80

Funding has been allocated from the County's ARPA 2021 award and supports Treasury Expense Category Public Sector Capacity - Effective Serice Delivery.
