

SUBJECT: Purchase of Lucas Chest Compression Systems for Fire & Emergency Services. MEETING DATE: May 2, 2023

SUGGESTED ACTION:

Consider approval for the purchase of two (2) Lucas Chest Compression Systems from Stryker Medical in the amount of \$36,851.80 for Fire & Emergency Services.

FACTS AND ISSUES:

Fire & Emergency Services is in need of two (2) additional Lucas Chest Compression Systems. The Lucas device provides automated chest compressions for patients in cardiac arrest which alleviates the need for a Paramedic to be committed to chest compressions, allowing them to perform other lifesaving interventions.

When Squad 20 went in service, one of the devices had to be pulled off of an outlaying engine. This purchase will replace the device on the outlaying engine and add a device to another outlaying engine, giving the County Lucas systems on every squad and five (5) outlaying engines.

EMS has the funds to purchase two systems in its FY23 operating budget.
