SUGGESTED ACTION:

Consider approval of an updated Fire & Emergency Services Intergovernmental Agreement (IGA) with the City of Nelson.

FACTS AND ISSUES:

The existing Fire & Emergency Services Intergovernmental Agreement (IGA) between the City of Nelson and Cherokee County is being revised to reflect that the City of Nelson will no longer be collecting Cherokee County fire taxes for the portion of the city located in Pickens County. The Pickens County Fire Department will be the first to respond to the Pickens County side of the city.

The agreement is for a five-year term, with automatic renewal for an additional five years unless one or both parties takes affirmative action not to renew at the end of the initial term. The agreement also includes the County performing fire inspection services for the City.

The City of Nelson approved this updated IGA at its meeting of December 5, 2024.
