BACKGROUND INFORMATION:

On December 3, 2021, Chairman Anderson was notified by Florida Department of State that the State Historic Preservation Office had prepared a Nomination Proposal for McCollum Hall. (Attached.)

By letter dated February 4, 2022, the Florida Department of State communicated that the Florida National Register Review Board had recommended that McCollum Hall be formally nominated for listing on the National Register of Historic Places (Attached).

On February 10, 2022 Mr. Patterson, McCollum Redevelopment, requested that the Community Redevelopment Agency (CRA) cover the cost associated with the preparation of an application to have McCollum Hall considered for nomination to the National Register of Historic Places. While the CRA did not contract with Cardno to prepare the application, and is under no obligation to pay, the request is brought to the board for consideration since the former developer is no longer associated with the property. An invoice from Cardno with a balance due of \$7,542.00 is attached. (Attached).
