EXPLANATION:

On May 13, 2026, the City Council voted (5-0) to deny the request for a Major PDP Amendment for Jordan Creek East based on failure of the property owner to meet its burden of demonstrating that its request to significantly increase the approved density of the project through the Amendment was supported by the criteria of Section 3.4.1.3.a.i. of the City of Bradenton Land Use Regulations, as further described below:

1. The Property Owner failed to demonstrate quality of design to justify the additional density request. The site plan was largely unchanged from the existing, approved plan, which provided for significantly less density. The Amendment also sought to reduce the required perimeter landscaped buffer below the Code required 25'.
2. The Property Owner failed to address contributions to public facilities.
3. The limited open space and recreation area proposed was unchanged from the existing, approved plan and did not justify the requested increase in density.

4. The proposed density of the Amendment significantly exceeds that of adjoining single-family detached residential lots, and compatibility is further compromised by the request for a reduced landscaped buffer.
