EXPLANATION:

This agreement renews the maintenance and compensation contract between the City of Bradenton and the Florida Department of Transportation (FDOT). Under Contract No. ARW43, the City will maintain 67 state-owned traffic signals as part of Financial Project No. 413639-1-88-01, with a total compensation of \$305,659.00. The agreement will be in effect from July 1, 2026, through June 30, 2027, ensuring continued upkeep of essential traffic signal infrastructure.

FINANCIAL IMPACT:

Funding will be allocated from the operating budget of the Electrical Maintenance Division under the General Fund (001), Division (51940), Traffic Signal Repair & Maintenance (546500). This funding supports the continued maintenance of state-owned traffic signals and infrastructure upkeep.
