EXPLANATION:

The City of Bradenton has been awarded \$1,000,000 in HUD Community Project Funding (CPF) for infrastructure and drainage improvements associated with the City Park project located at 1447 9th Street West. The grant will support eligible project costs, including construction administration, direct purchases, and construction activities. The approval of the Federal Award Agreement will allow the City to establish the required HUD Action Plan, request reimbursement of eligible expenditures, and proceed with project implementation in accordance with federal requirements.

FINANCIAL IMPACT:

Acceptance of \$1,000,000 in federal grant funding. No additional City funding is required for this action beyond the previously identified local matching and project funding sources. Grant funds will be appropriated in accordance with the approved project budget.
