**EXPLANATION:**

On January 27, 2022 the City of Bradenton entered into an Interlocal Agreement with Manatee County which designated Drug Free Manatee as Manatee County's opioid taskforce to serve in an advisory capacity to the Board of County Commissioners regarding expenditure of settlement awards resulting from lawsuits filed against opioid manufacturers, distributors, and retailers.

The Board now finds it necessary to establish an Opioid Abatement Coordinating Council to replace Drug Free Manatee as the County's opioid taskforce, in order to establish a more centralized, efficient, and transparent framework for opioid abatement efforts in the County, as reflected in Resolution No. R-25-045. This First Amendment to Interlocal Agreement reflects the change from Drug Free Manatee taskforce to the Opioid Abatement Coordinating Council.
