#### **EXPLANATION:**

After having been awarded a FDEP Resiliency Grant, the City advertised a Request for Qualifications for the purpose of selecting a qualified Proposer to provide professional engineering design, permitting and construction inspection services of the LS03 expansion/LS13 demolition. Only one proposal was received. FDEP suggested that only one vendor would not be sufficient and recommended the City re-strategized to remove the planning piece of the project. The City agreed with FDEP and decided to quote out and award the planning piece of the project to one of the consultants in the professional services library. The City is recommending Jacobs Engineering Group complete the Basis of Design Review (BODR), which is the planning document that will drive the design of the lift station improvements.

#### **FINANCIAL IMPACT:**

The FDEP is providing 50% funding for the planning, design, and construction for the expansion of LS03 and demolition of LS13. The total cost estimate for the project is \$5,875,750.00. The BODR will encumber \$207,663.00 in GL account 40859000-563000-24523.
