EXPLANATION:

Public Works and Utilities currently utilizes Samsara's GPS and fleet management system for tracking municipal fleet operations. Approval is requested for an additional cost in the amount of \$12,089.56 for seven (7) cameras for the remaining term of 54 months under the existing contract approved by City Council on October 8, 2025. This additional cost is necessary due to the expansion of the new vehicles for the Solid Waste fleet approved by Council. These new vehicles require camera installation to support the Solid Waste Division's proof of service program. The City currently has seven (7) GPS/telematics units in stock; however, the seven (7) additional cameras are needed to fully equip these additional vehicles. There are no changes to the terms and conditions of the original contract; however, the total contract amount will increase from \$281,296.50 to \$293,386.06. The revised total first-year cost is \$43,411.66, with an annual recurring cost of \$62,493.60.

The necessary funds for this purchase have been allocated across all seventeen (17) divisions within Public Works and Utilities.
