EXPLANATION:

On September 10, 2025, the CRA Board unanimously approved an Interdepartmental Funding Application for up to \$250,000 to install sunshades at Rossi Park. This project is a key initiative under the CRA's Sustainable Redevelopment Plan, designed to enhance the Downtown CRA District. Following a comprehensive review and internal discussions, the City is now requesting an adjustment to the previously approved design and physical placement of these structures to better optimize the park's layout and utility.

The installation of these high-quality, durable shade structures remains a priority to provide essential sun protection for residents and visitors. By refining the design and placement, the City aims to maximize the shade's footprint, encouraging year-round use of the park. This investment continues to support public well-being while strengthening the area's economic and social vitality by transforming Rossi Park into a more comfortable and attractive destination.
