#### **EXPLANATION:**

The Florida Department of Environmental Protection (FDEP) has awarded the City of Bradenton \$19,166,503 in Clean Water State Revolving Fund (CWSRF) Supplemental Appropriation funding through the Hurricane Helene & Hurricane Milton Disaster Recovery Program. This award is offered at 100% principal forgiveness, providing significant federal disaster recovery assistance to strengthen the City's wastewater infrastructure.

Improvements funded under this program will address aging wastewater assets, enhance system reliability during extreme weather events, mitigate infiltration/inflow impacts, and support long-term regulatory compliance. Acceptance of the award requires the City to submit a formal CWSRF Loan Application package, including an authorizing Resolution and a Legal Opinion from the City Attorney.

Staff requests City Council approval of the Authorizing Resolution and submission of the Clean Water SRF Loan Application and execution of the subsequent Loan Agreement needed to secure the Supplemental Appropriation funding.
