EXPLANATION:

Lasting Manatee is the program through which Manatee County allocates Community Development Block Grant Disaster Recovery (CDBG-DR) funds received from HUD. In January 2025, Manatee County was designated as a direct recipient of \$252,711,000 in CDBG-DR funds to address unmet needs resulting from hurricanes Debby, Helene, and Milton. These funds will be used to rebuild housing and infrastructure and reduce risks associated with future storms. The County plans to begin accepting proposals for infrastructure projects starting June 1, 2026. The City of Bradenton has been closely monitoring this program and has developed several projects for submission. The City is ready to submit multiple infrastructure projects based on identified needs and available funds, following an internal review.

FINANCIAL IMPACT:

The City of Bradenton is prepared to commit local funds as needed; however, costs have not yet been identified.
