A relocation of one of the primary monitoring wells and delays due to weather (2024 hurricane season) delayed completion of the well system and subsequent testing required by FDEP. The Construction Engineering Inspection (CEI) extension is for the professional geologists to continue testing and monitoring for required regulatory submittals.

A reduction in the overall construction price of the well system (4 wells total) will allow the increased CEI cost to be covered with the initial encumbrance of funds for the project - GL account 40859000563000-24522.
