**EXPLANATION:**

The Public Works Department has submitted to CRA Staff an Interdepartmental Funding Application for the CRA Downtown Maintenance Initiative.

The Downtown Maintenance Initiative maintains the Downtown CRA area by removing all graffiti and trash on a daily basis. Power washing all surfaces on main street, reporting crime, homeless camps, and property damage in the corridor area. Beautification efforts include planting native plants and flowers both in the ground and planters located on Main Street.

The requested funds will be used for operational costs and equipment.
