**SUBJECT:** Interlocal Agreement (ILA) between the City of Bradenton and Manatee County for the County owned Administration Center Parking Garage located at 414 10th Street West, Bradenton, Florida 34205

**EXPLANATION:**

Manatee County owns an Administration Center Parking Garage located at 414 10th Street West, Bradenton, Florida 34205, which includes 97 metered parking spaces for the public with signage, vehicle entryways, and pedestrian access.

The City shall solely be responsible for parking enforcement within the Parking Facilities, including enforcement of parking rules and use of payment kiosks, and maintenance, repair, and replacement of payment kiosks, and parking signage. The City is not responsible for parking enforcement in the County employee parking area, located beyond the gate on Level 4.

The City shall be solely responsible for collecting the revenues generated by the parking kiosks and the revenues generated by levying fines for failure to follow the parking rules. All Parking Facilities Revenues collected by the City shall be used by the City to pay the costs incurred by the City in performing its obligations as set forth in Section 21.

The Interlocal Agreement shall remain in effect until September 30, 2025. The

City and the County may renew this Interlocal Agreement annually for four years, in writing, for a maximum term not to exceed 5 years. To the extent the Parking Structure or Parking Facilities are no longer inhabitable or are torn down or demolished, this Interlocal Agreement shall terminate automatically.

**FINANCIAL IMPACT:**

All Parking Facilities revenues collected by the City shall be used by the City to pay the costs incurred by the City in performing its obligations.
