AN ORDINANCE OF THE CITY OF BRADENTON, FLORIDA, AMENDING CHAPTER 6, ALCOHOLIC BEVERAGES, TO MODIFY THE HOURS OF SALE AND CONSUMPTION OF ALCOHOL TO REFLECT THAT NO ALCOHOL MAY BE SOLD OR CONSUMED ON PREMISES AFTER 2:00 A.M.; AMENDING SECTION 3 OF ORDINANCE 4047 TO REFLECT THAT NO ALCOHOL MAY BE SOLD OR CONSUMED ON PREMISES AFTER 2:00 A.M.; PROVIDING FOR CODIFICATION; PROVIDING FOR SEVERABILITY; PROVIDING FOR REPEAL OF ORDINANCES IN CONFLICT; AND PROVIDING FOR AN EFFECTIVE DATE.

EXPLANATION:

At the August 14, 2024 City Council meeting, Council approved Ordinance 4047 that set forth instructions on how establishments may apply for an After Midnight Permit, public safety measures, and the violation process with the City of Bradenton.

At that meeting, Council expressed interest in amending the City's Code of Ordinances to state that, for establishments holding a license to sell alcohol, no alcohol may be sold or consumed on the property after 2:00 a.m.
