AN ORDINANCE OF THE CITY OF BRADENTON, FLORIDA, AMENDING CHAPTER 26, ARTICLE II, SECTION 26-38, DISASTER EMERGENCIES; COUNCIL RESPONSIBILITY, TO ALLOW THE MAYOR OR VICE-MAYOR TO DECLARE A DISASTER EMERGENCY AND ISSUE EMERGENCY ORDERS IN THE EVENT THE QUORUM OF CITY COUNCIL CANNOT BE ATTAINED IN PERSON WITHIN A REASONABLE TIME; PROVIDING FOR CODIFICATION; PROVIDING FOR SEVERABILITY; AND PROVIDING FOR AN EFFECTIVE DATE.
