**SUGGESTED ACTION:** Council approval of the lowest quote received from Spectrum Underground at \$381,025.00, +20% for a total of \$457,230.00.

**EXPLANATION:**

The City received a grant for Resiliency Funds from FDEP to fund 50% of the expansion of LS03, reconstruction of the LS13 collection system to flow to LS03, and demolish the existing LS13. Due to the multiple severe weather events experienced in 2024, the need to complete an interim solution to keep LS13 became critical. Loss of the lift station will cause loss of service to the residents in the area as well as the potential for a raw sewage spill into the Manatee River. After reviewing several solutions, the most expedient and cost effective solution is to install a temporary lift station until the project funded through FDEP is completed. Both the expansion of LS03 and the reconstruction of the collection system will need to be completed prior to completely removing the temporary lift station. The process is anticipated to take between 3 - 5 years.

**FINANCIAL IMPACT:**

The project is being funded through the existing LS Rehabilitation budget; GL acct 40859000-563000-25506, approved by Council in September 2024.
