AN ORDINANCE OF THE CITY OF BRADENTON, FLORIDA, AMENDING THE CITY OF BRADENTON CODE OF ORDINANCES SECTION 26-38 TO MODIFY PROVISIONS RELATING TO THE POWERS, DUTIES AND PROCEDURES OF CITY OFFICIALS IN A DISASTER EMERGENCY; PROVIDING FOR CODIFICATION; PROVIDING FOR THE REPEAL OF ORDINANCES IN CONFLICT; PROVIDING FOR SEVERABILITY; AND PROVIDING FOR AN EFFECTIVE DATE.

EXPLANATION:

At the August 28, 2024 City Council meeting, Attorney Rudacille was directed to draft an ordinance revising the process for extending a state of disaster emergency.

Ordinance 4053 will only allow for the Mayor or City Administrator to extend the state of disaster emergency; the state of emergency must still be declared at first by City Council.
