If the action is to recommend approval, staff recommends the following stipulations be applied to

the approval:

1. The dock shall be kept in good working order and condition, to not degrade from the value of nearby properties. Dock design, including amenities, shall meet the requirements of the City of Bradenton Code of Ordinances.

- 2. Lighting must be according to FDEP requirements.
- 3. Any extension of utilities, staging of equipment and material, or access in or across the public right-of-way shall require appropriate City ROW permitting.

4. All other applicable state or federal permits be obtained before commencement of the development. Any conditions associated with the required FDEP permit will be met at time of construction.
