**SUBJECT:** **QUASI-JUDICIAL:** RESOLUTION 24-76 - PUBLIC HEARING

**SUGGESTED ACTION:** Motion to either approve or deny Resolution 24-76, Case SU.24.3129, with the following stipulations:

1. The approved Resolution, including the approved site plan and conditions shall be on display and accessible on the Property during business hours.
2. Within 30 days following the approval, the Property Owner shall execute an Indemnification Agreement in a form acceptable to the City.
3. Clear pedestrian access on the public sidewalk of no less than 5' shall be maintained at all times in a way that neither seating, tables, or umbrellas affect the ingress/egress of travel, the safety or pedestrian and traffic circulation.
4. The property/business owner shall obtain all State licenses permitting the sale of alcohol as part of the sidewalk café.
5. Any cleaning solution used to clean the sidewalk café area shall be approved by the Bradenton Public Works Department.
6. Any future increase in seating for the sidewalk café area shall be approved by City Council.

Planning Commission met on September 18, 2024, and voted 5-0 to recommend to City Council approval with stipulations of Resolution 24-76.

Michael W. Adams of Mike Carter Construction Inc., agent for The Carter Family Revocable Living Trust, has submitted a Special Use application requesting permission to allow a sidewalk café with alcohol sales at 417 12<sup>th</sup> Street West (Jennings Downtown Provisions).
