EXPLANATION:

Code Enforcement has submitted a CRA Interdepartmental Funding Application to support its essential efforts in removing blight and ensuring safe, healthy living conditions within the CRA District. If approved, the requested funding will cover code enforcement services within the CRA district areas, as well as the costs associated with a new proposed pilot program.

As stated above, this funding request includes a proposed Code Enforcement pilot program designed to assist CRA district residents who are unable to maintain their properties. Geared primarily toward low-income elderly and disabled homeowners, the program will require owner consent to remove junk, debris, dangerous trees, and derelict vehicles. Additionally, it will provide exterior power cleaning and non-chain-link fence repairs.

Code Enforcement is supported by Sections 2.2.1.1.2, 2.3.3.1.2, 4.3.2.1.2, and 4.3.2.1.7 in all three (3) CRA Community Redevelopment Plans.
