EXPLANATION:

The Bradenton Police Department is presenting Connect Bradenton, a new program that will enhance community safety by utilizing FususOne by Axon.

This program strengthens public-private and allows businesses and community members to work closely with law enforcement. By allowing the community to participate, emergency preparedness and response to criminal activity and emergencies will be improved. The Fusus system helps increase community security while also respecting personal privacy. Businesses and residents are encouraged to give the Bradenton Police Department access to their camera feed in case of nearby emergencies by using the CORE device. The program will offer a Core Lite Extended bundle to locations within the CRA District areas that are determined to possess strategic significance vital to improving law enforcement's situational awareness.

A potential host location will be offered the following with the cost covered by CRA CPTED Grant:

Core Lite Extended Bundle

Sharing of up to 4 Cameras (1TB storage) and software/hardware warranty.

COST to CRA per location

- *\$450: One-Time fee – includes installation and first year subscription*
- *\$300: Provides funding for two (2) additional years of subscription (\$150/year)*
