AN ORDINANCE OF THE CITY OF BRADENTON, FLORIDA, AMENDING CHAPTER 18, ARTICLE II, SECTION 18-36 OF THE CODE OF ORDINANCES, ENTITLED "UNSAFE STRUCTURES" TO PROVIDE FOR THE CITY COUNCIL TO HEAR APPEALS RELATING TO UNSAFE STRUCTURES AND TO ADD AN APPEAL FEE; PROVIDING FOR SEVERABILITY; PROVIDING FOR REPEAL OF ORDINANCES IN CONFLICT; AND PROVIDING FOR AN EFFECTIVE DATE.

EXPLANATION:

Chapter 18, Article II, Section 18-36 of the Code of Ordinances provides for the regulation of unsafe structures. The Code currently provides that the Construction Trade Board is the body to hear such appeals. As the City has encountered difficulties in constituting the board, the City Council will appoint itself as the body to hear appeals under the unsafe structure provisions. The City will also charge a fee for appeals in order to offset the administrative costs associated with conducting said appeals.
