AGENDA SUBJECT: Approval of Kingman Main Street Route 66 Native Plant Walk

SUMMARY:

Kingman Main Street has been awarded a \$50,000.00 grant from the Arizona Route 66 Grant Cycle for the proposal Titles, "The Route 66 Native Plant Walk". Kingman Main Street will take on responsibility for this corridor. Fully funding the landscaping (sourcing plants, planting, and professional maintenance schedule (We are proactively assembling a dedicated team of expert community volunteers to adopt the nature train and lead ongoing stewardship. This coalition will include volunteers from the ASU Agricultural Extension's Master Gardeners, the Cerbat Garden Club, Mohave Permaculture Program, Dig It Community Children's Garden, and our own Kingman Main Street volunteers). Kingman Main Street is requesting permission to utilize this city-owned right-of-way for the installation.

The City of Kingman would be responsible for the water meter installation, back flow device upgrades and ongoing monthly water costs.

FISCAL IMPACT:

There will be a one-time negative fiscal impact of approximately \$1,000 to the General Fund for the water meter installation and back flow device upgrades. There will be a one-time positive fiscal impact of \$874 to the Water Expansion Fund for water capacity fees.

The amount of water that will be used is unknown at this time, but all citywide landscape irrigation costs are covered through the Water Operating Fund.
