SUMMARY STATEMENT

A public hearing is required within 60 days of passage of such a moratorium, and on September 13, 2023, the City Council set the public hearing date for October 18, 2023. The moratorium is scheduled to be in effect for 12 months, or until September 13, 2024, unless terminated or renewed by the City Council for one or more sixmonth periods.

The purpose of this item is to hold the public hearing and hear from the public. The Council may 1) leave the moratorium in place and take no action based on public comment, 2) use the input received by the public to make additional findings justifying the moratorium beyond those that are contained in Ordinance No. 2023-13, 3) use the input received to modify the moratorium by adding exemptions that are consistent with the purpose of the moratorium; or 4) decide to repeal the moratorium altogether.
