SUMMARY STATEMENT

The WA State Criminal Justice Training Commission (CJTC) recently concluded a study regarding the use of the Sig Sauer P320 handgun. The study concluded the Sig Sauer P320 presents a safety risk due to alleged accidental discharge and the CJTC will not allow the weapon to be used on their property or for any training venue's sanctioned by the CJTC. This presents an insurmountable obstacle for any law enforcement agencies to use the P320 as a duty weapon. The Sig Sauer P320 was a popular option among law enforcement agencies, including the Poulsbo Police Department (PPD). We have 6 Sig Sauer P320's in use currently and we need to replace them, along with essential accessories. The total replacement cost for these weapons systems will be approximately \$9,100. The PD has a quote to sell these 6 weapons to a dealer for \$1,800 which would be used for partial funding. This Budget Amendment is requesting \$7,300 as the final expense.
