24-65 Resolution to Approve Charter Ballot Language - Residency **Subject:**

Requirements

Per the recommendation of the Charter Review Working Group, City Council is **Background Brief:**

> being asked to consider changes to Section 5.1 of the Saline City Charter. These changes, if accepted by the voters, would reduce the residency

requirement for elected office to one year and to be at the time of appointment for non-elected committee appointments. The reduction to one year for elected officials is designed to be more consistent with case law and generally less restrictive. Similarly, the change to appointee length of residency would align better with current practice and increase the pool of available applicants for vacancies. This resolution also adopts gender neutral terms throughout the

section similar to past amendments.

The ballot language and resolution are subject to review by the State of Michigan Office of the Attorney General prior to inclusion on the ballot. If approved, the ballot initiative would go on the August 6, 2024 Regular

Michigan State Primary Election.

The Charter Review Working Group presented its recommendations to **Previous Action:**

> Council on September 11, 2023. Language for the first two ballot initiatives was approved at that same meeting, and both measures were subsequently

approved by voters on February 27, 2024.
