**SUBJECT:** Notice of Intent to Hold a Public Hearing of Delinquent Trash Charges for Calendar Year 2025

**ACTION:**

Provide a Notice of Intent to hold a Public Hearing on June 10th, 2026 at 6:00 pm in the City Council chambers, for placing a levy on parcels with unpaid charges for trash collection services.

**SUMMARY:**

Notice of Intent to Hold a Public Hearing of Delinquent Trash Charges for Calendar Year 2025

**BACKGROUND:**

On March 23rd, 2011, the City Council adopted Resolution 2011-18 to establish special assessments and liens against parcels of land for unpaid and delinquent charges for trash collection services. On October 26th, 2022, the City entered into an exclusive franchise agreement with the waste hauler CR&R, which went into effect on December 1st, 2022. Under the agreement with CR&R, the City agreed to annually levy properties for residential trash hauling service charges delinquent from the previous calendar year. The waste hauler has mailed out notices to all affected property owners of record. The City Council shall hold a Public Hearing on June 10th, 2026, and adopt a resolution affirming the report on the delinquent accounts for collection on the property tax rolls.

**DISCUSSION:**

Currently, the delinquent charges for CR&R total 956 parcels in the amount of \$467,041.79. By the time of the Public Hearing date, the amount to be placed on the tax rolls may be lower due to payments being made on the delinquent accounts.

**FISCAL IMPACT:**

After collection of the special assessment and remittance of those assessments to the waste hauler, the City shall receive its proportionate share of the franchise fee for the respective amount.
