SUBJECT: Request to Annually Raise MIA/POW Flag at the Wildomar Cemetery for Memorial Day

ACTION:

Approve the annual display of the Missing in Action (MIA)/Prisoner of War (POW) commemorative flag at the Wildomar Cemetery District flagpole on Memorial Day in accordance with the City Flag Display Policy.

SUMMARY:

Staff recommends City Council approval to annually display the MIA/POW flag at the Wildomar Cemetery on Memorial Day, in accordance with the City's Flag Display Policy. The flag would be flown to honor military personnel who were Prisoners of War or Missing in Action.

BACKGROUND:

The City Flag Display Policy, adopted on April 13, 2022, establishes guidelines for the display of flags at designated City locations, including the Wildomar Cemetery. The policy authorizes the display of commemorative flags, such as the Missing in Action (MIA)/Prisoner of War (POW) flag, upon approval by the City Council during a regular or special meeting. A copy of the policy is included as Attachment A.

DISCUSSION:

Staff requests that the City Council approve the annual recurring display of the MIA/POW commemorative flag at the Wildomar Cemetery District flagpole each Memorial Day in accordance with the City Flag Display Policy, unless otherwise directed by future City Council action.

By motion, the City Council would authorize the recurring annual display as an official commemorative observance honoring military personnel who were Prisoners of War or remain Missing in Action, thereby eliminating the need for separate annual approvals while remaining consistent with the intent and provisions of the City's Flag Display Policy
