SUBJECT: Veterans and First Responders Memorial Ad-Hoc Committee

ACTION:

Appoint two members of the City Council to serve on the Veterans and First Responders Memorial ad-hoc committee for the purpose of evaluating options for the design, location, funding and implementation of a Veterans and First Responders Memorial for City Council consideration.

SUMMARY:

This item is being presented to appoint two Councilmembers to an ad-hoc committee to review options for establishing the City's first Veterans' and First Responders Memorial.

BACKGROUND:

On April 8, 2026, the City Council held a Veterans and First Responders Memorial Stakeholder Engagement Workshop as part of the Cemetery's Master Plan Update. The stakeholder engagement process was intended to ensure that the memorial's planning and design reflect the community's values, expectations, and collective vision. After collecting feedback from the City Council, residents, and stakeholders, Councilmember Moore, at the May 13, 2026, Council Meeting, requested that a future agenda item be added to create an ad hoc memorial committee to continue planning and designing the City's first memorial.

DISCUSSION:

This is the opportunity for the City Council to appoint two members to serve on the ad-hoc committee. Upon completion, the ad-hoc committee will present its findings and recommendations to the City Council for consideration and final approval.
