A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF WILDOMAR, CALIFORNIA, CONFIRMING THE REPORT OF DELINQUENT TRASH ACCOUNTS AND REQUESTING THE DELINQUENCIES BE PLACED ON THE PROPERTY TAX ROLL

SUMMARY:

Public Hearing for Delinquent Trash Charges for 2025

BACKGROUND:

Under the terms of the Franchise Agreement with CR&R, the waste hauler is to deliver a report of residential account delinquencies from the previous calendar year along with a request that the City submit the account delinquency information to the Riverside County Assessor's Office for placement on the tax roll. The waste hauler has done so and therefore the City is authorized by the State Law (Government Code sections 38790.1 and 25831) and the terms of the Franchise Agreements to hold this hearing to confirm the reports submitted by the waste hauler CR&R.

DISCUSSION:

On May 13th, 2026, the City Council provided a Notice of Intent to hold a Public Hearing on June 10th, 2026, informing the public that the City Council will consider adopting a resolution confirming the reports of the delinquent accounts so that the balances may be collected with the property tax roll. CR&R has mailed notices of this hearing to the residential customers listed on the delinquency reports at least 10 days prior to this hearing. Notices of the public hearing were published in a local publication twice leading up to the hearing.

As of May 20th, delinquent charges for CR&R total 798 parcels in the amount of \$419,255.51. These amounts will be placed on the property tax rolls if they are not paid by Friday, July 24th, 2026.

FISCAL IMPACT:

After collection of the special assessment and remittance of those assessments to the waste hauler, the City shall receive its proportionate share of the franchise fee for the respective amount.
