SUBJECT: Second Reading and Adoption of Ordinance No. 264 adding Chapter 5.80 (Shopping Carts) to Title 5 (Business Regulation) of the Municipal Code.

ACTION:

1. Determine that the Municipal Code Amendment ("MCA") No. 2026-06, and its adopting Ordinance No. 264, is exempt under the California Environmental Quality Act (CEQA) and CEQA Guidelines, pursuant to the common sense exemption, Section 15061 (b)(3) of the CEQA Guidelines; and
2. Conduct a second reading by title only and adopt Ordinance No. 264 as entitled below, amending Title 5 (Business Regulation) of the Wildomar Municipal Code:

ORDINANCE NO. 264

AN ORDINANCE OF THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF WILDOMAR ADDING CHAPTER 5.80 (SHOPPING CARTS) TO TITLE 5 (BUSINESS REGULATIONS) OF THE WILDOMAR MUNICIPAL CODE RELATING TO SHOPPING CART RETRIEVAL, RETURN, IMPOUNDMENT, COST RECOVERY, NUISANCE ABATEMENT, AND NOTICE PROCEDURES.

BACKGROUND:

At its July 8, 2026 meeting, the City Council introduced Ordinance No. 264, approving Municipal Code Amendment ("MCA") 2026-06. The ordinance is now being presented to the City Council for a second reading by title only and adoption. Additionally, on July 8, 2026, the City Council also determined that MCA 2026-06 and its adopting ordinance is exempt from the California Environmental Quality Act (CEQA) as a commonsense exemption under Section 15061 (b)(3) of the CEQA Guidelines as "general rulemaking".

FISCAL IMPACT:

The fiscal impacts associated with the drafting, legal review, and implementation of this ordinance are covered by the Department's Operating Budget of General Fund.
