SUBJECT: Acceptance of a \$10,000.00 Keep Tennessee Beautiful Law Enforcement Grant

INTRODUCTION:

The purpose of this agenda item is to request approval from the Board of Mayor and Aldermen to accept a \$10,000.00 overtime pay reimbursement grant from Keep Tennessee Beautiful.

BACKGROUND:

In June of this year, the Collierville Police Department was given the opportunity to apply for an overtime grant in the amount of \$10,000.00 from the Keep Tennessee Beautiful organization. This grant is designed for overtime pay to enforce litter law and unsecured/escaping load law violations.

DISCUSSION:

The Keep Tennessee Beautiful Law Enforcement Grant targets littering and unsecured /escaping loads from vehicles on Tennessee roadways. The grant period starts upon the approval of the BMA and will conclude In October 2026. During the grant timeframe CPD will conduct overtime saturations on Hwy 385 and surrounding roads.

Under the Keep Tennessee Beautiful Law Enforcement Grant, the state will reimburse officer's overtime and benefits not to exceed \$10,000.00. The saturations will be conducted between 8:00 am and 7:00 pm. Monday through Friday depending on the availability of officers.

BUDGET IMPACT:

A budget amendment request to appropriate the grant will be presented on a future agenda.
