SUBJECT: Fifth Contract Amendment for Police Uniforms

INTRODUCTION:

The purpose of this agenda item is to request approval from the Board of Mayor and Aldermen for the 5th amendment to the Police Department's uniform contract GS-23-01289 (A) with CMS Uniforms of Nashville, Tennessee.

BACKGROUND:

On August 22, 2022, the Town of Collierville entered uniform contract GS-23-01289 (A) with CMS Uniforms of Nashville, Tennessee. The contract included basic work and dress uniforms required by the department. The contract specified items which will be held on contract for a term of twelve (12) months and subject to four (4) renewals. On August 11, 2025, the BMA renewed the contract for twelve (12) months. The contract is a unit price contract for approved police uniform items.

DISCUSSION:

This uniform contract, GS-23-01289 (A), requires an amendment due to Two (2) items being discontinued and replaced with new items with subsequent price increases. One (1) item requires a price adjustment that was inadvertently missed in the Fourth Amendment to the Contract reflecting Blauer's 5% increase. One (1) item is being added to secure contractual pricing.
