SUBJECT: Renewal of West Tennessee Regional Recycled Material Intergovernmental

Agreement

INTRODUCTION:

The purpose of this agenda item is to approve the renewal of the Recycle Material Processing Intergovernmental Agreement with West Tennessee Regional Recycling Hub for an additional twelve (12) month period.

BACKGROUND:

The Sanitation Division collects approximately 2,000 tons of curbside household recycling material annually from Town residents. Once collected, recycle material is delivered to the Town's transfer station and then transported via tractor trailer to be processed. On average, the Sanitation Division transports four (4) loads per week averaging ten (10) tons per load.

DISCUSSION:

On August 12, 2019, the Mayor and Board of Alderman approved an intergovernmental agreement with West Tennessee Regional Recycling Hub for the processing of Town curbside recycle material. This agreement term is for five (5) years with an option to renew for an additional five (5) (twelve month) renewals. This is the second renewal of this intergovernmental agreement.

West Tennessee Regional Recycling Hub has performed satisfactory over the past twelve months, and Public Works staff recommend the intergovernmental agreement be renewed for and additional twelve (12) month period. There will be no increase with this renewal.
