SUBJECT: Review of Bids and Award of Contract for the FY 2027 Street Resurfacing Program

INTRODUCTION:

The purpose of this agenda item is to award the annual contract for the Town of Collierville's Street Resurfacing Program for FY 2027.

BACKGROUND:

This project involves patching, leveling and asphalt overlay of various Town street. \$3,001,759.00 was budgeted in the Streets and Drainage Fund and \$1,037,741.00 is in the State Street Aid Fund for the annual resurfacing project. The total amount budgeted for FY 2027 is \$4,039,500.00.

DISCUSSION:

Following the approval of the proposed street list, Public Works personnel submitted a requisition to the Procurement Department for the street resurfacing project. The Procurement Department prepared a bid and notified (18) vendors. On August 26, 2025, the Procurement Department opened (5) bids for the annual resurfacing project. Gibson Paving, Inc. submitted the lowest bid for the project with a total of \$2,799,661.00 and an alternate bid (additional add-on streets) of \$397,861.00 for a total of \$3,197,522.00. Additional streets will be brought before the Board in the Spring due to \$841,978.00 of remaining funds available after the bid opening.
