SUBJECT: Purchase of Replacement Vehicle through Statewide Contract

INTRODUCTION:

The purpose of this agenda item is to request approval from the Mayor and Board of Aldermen to purchase one public safety utility vehicle through Tennessee Statewide Contract #209.

BACKGROUND:

The FY27 Annual Operating Budget includes \$77,523 in line item 110-42200-944-1, funded through the General Fund, for the purchase of a Chevrolet Tahoe 4x4 Special Service Vehicle (SSV) designed for public safety operations.

The vehicle identified for replacement was evaluated by the Town's Fleet Manager, Allen Hataway, using the Town's established replacement criteria, including the vehicle's age, mileage, serviceability, intended use, and historical maintenance and repair costs.

DISCUSSION:

Wilson County Motors currently holds State Contract #209 for General Motors vehicles. The contract price for the Chevrolet Tahoe Special Service Vehicle (SSV) is \$54,391.80.

This vehicle will replace F-59, a 2013 Chevrolet Tahoe that currently has 117,363 miles. Upon delivery of the replacement vehicle, F-59 will be declared surplus in accordance with the Town's surplus property procedures.

Upon approval by the Mayor and Board of Aldermen, the replacement vehicle will be purchased using funds from the Fire Department's operating budget.
