3.1 Revisions to Board Policies and Administrative Regulations on Immigration Enforcement

Department/Category: DISTRICT ORGANIZATION AND BOARD OPERATION

Background Information:

Periodically the Board is presented with recommended revisions to Board Policies (BP), Board Bylaws (BB), Administrative Regulations (AR), and/or Exhibits (E). The recommendations are based on changes in law, the Education Code, Government Code, and/or rewording for better understanding.

Reports:

Recent changes in the law require adoptions and revisions of policy and regulation to include requirements created by recent legislation and the Attorney General’s December 2025, “Promoting a Safe and Secure Learning Environment for All: Guidance and Model Policies to Assist California’s TK-12 Schools in Responding to Requests for Access and Information for Immigration Enforcement Purposes.”

New Law, AB 495 (2025), requires districts to make their policies related to response to immigration enforcement that include the Attorney General's 2025 model policy language or its equivalent available to the California Department of Education (CDE) by March 1, 2026 through CDE’s online portal.
