BACKGROUND/SUMMARY:

On May 21st, 2025, six outstanding Hollister High School graduates were recognized as recipients of the League of Latin American Citizens (LULAC) scholarship at the Hollister High Awards Night Presentation. With approximately 138,423 members and supporters throughout the United States and Puerto Rico, LULAC is the largest and oldest Hispanic organization in the United States. LULAC advances the economic condition, educational attainment, political influence, housing, health, and civil rights of Hispanic Americans through community-based programs operating at more than 525 LULAC councils nationwide. The organization involves and serves all Hispanic nationality groups.

Our local LULAC Council 2890 has been a stalwart presence in our community for over three decades, dating back to its establishment in 1987. For 38 years, they have been dedicated to empowering Hispanic youth and adults through various programs and initiatives, including the presentation of scholarships to high-achieving and deserving high school graduates.

The six scholarship recipients will be honored at the LULAC Scholarship Presentation on June 22, 2025, at the Community Foundation of San Benito County Epicenter Building (San Andreas Room) located at 440 San Benito Street, Hollister, at 2:00 pm.
